



About the Club

The UUC provides safe and affordable diving for students and community members. As a Uni club, we are affiliated with the UWA Sports and Recreation association however you don't have to be a student or have had anything to do with UWA to join. All you have to be is a keen diver - we welcome young and not-so-young and new and experienced divers. While our main focus is diving, we are a very social club and do some great après diving activities as well.

Equipment

We own an 8-metre dive boat, the TANTABIDDI, which can hold 12 divers. We also own two compressors (one portable) and a dual cab tray-back truck to tow the boat!

Dive Gear

We maintain complete SCUBA kits for hire for club members - 35 BCs, 14 computer regs, 21 analogue regs, and 56 tanks. We also hire wetsuits and weight belts. All the equipment is monitored and serviced regularly. We have everything you need to come diving with us.

Local dives

The UUC offers regular trips to Rottnest Island, Carnac Island and other local spots (number of divers and weather dependent). A weekend double dive at Rottnest including a lunch break on the Island is the most popular trip.

Clubrooms

The clubrooms are open at 6:30pm Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays for about 15-30 minutes Nov-April (see next page for a map). If you are booked on a dive, turn up at the clubrooms the evening before the dive to pay for the dive, hire gear and get the details for the following day. You must show your current UUC sticker every time you hire gear or pay for a boat dive.

For gear hire outside these times, appointments can be made with a person on the 'week day dive roster'. The dive roster is published on the club's website calendar, along with the roster volunteer's contact details.

Après Dive and Social Get Togethers

The club is very social and Social meetings are held on the first Wednesday of every month from 7.00pm, upstairs at the Irish Club in Subiaco. We often have special guests, who speak on a whole range of diving related subjects. Other times, the social meetings are a chance to catch up with fellow divers, discuss recent adventures and organise upcoming trips as well showcase photos from previous dives/trips.
